This discussion must include identification of the work activity, the specific hazards present, and the safe work requirements/controls (including PPE) to be used to alleviate/control the hazards.

KNOWN OR POTENTIAL HAZARDS	EXAMPLES	YES	NO	SAFE WORK CONTROLS
1. Dust	Nuisance, hazardous, combustible			
2. Floor Openings	Sky lights, hatch doors, manholes, gaps or voids			
3. Confined Space	Permit required? Egress, air quality, explosion hazards			
4. Hot Work	Cutting, Welding, Grinding			
5. Roof Work	Work level is greater than 10 feet above ground			
6. Fall Hazards	Working surface above 6'			
7. Ladders	Tie off points, restrictions			
8. Scaffolding	Bakers, Masonary, Tubular			
9. Aerial Lifts	Scissor, Boom etc. grounding? Power lines? Weight capacity of floor			

KNOWN OR POTENTIAL HAZARDS	EXAMPLES	YES	NO	SAFE WORK CONTROLS
<b>11. Lock and Tag</b>	Individual, Group, Customer			
<b>12. Site/Vehicle Traffic</b>	Signage, Barricades, Communication			
<b>13. Electrical Hazards</b>	De-energized or live			
<b>14. Asbestos Hazards</b>	Suspected, Confirmed			
<b>15. Lead Hazards</b>	Suspected, Confirmed			
<b>16. Hazardous Materials</b>	MSDS, PPE, Disposal			
<b>17. Respiratory Hazards</b>	Full face/half face, cartridge type, disposable			
<b>18. Elevated Noise</b>	Earplugs, earmuffs, combo.			
<b>19. Temperature Extremes</b>	Extreme heat or cold. Protective clothing			
<b>20. Other Contractors Present?</b>	What type of work, vicinity			
<b>21. Signs &amp; Barricades</b>	Caution tape, signage, danger tape, communication tags			
<b>22. Walking/Working Surfaces</b>	Ice, Oil, Water			
<b>23. Environmental</b>	Waste Water, VOC Compliance
